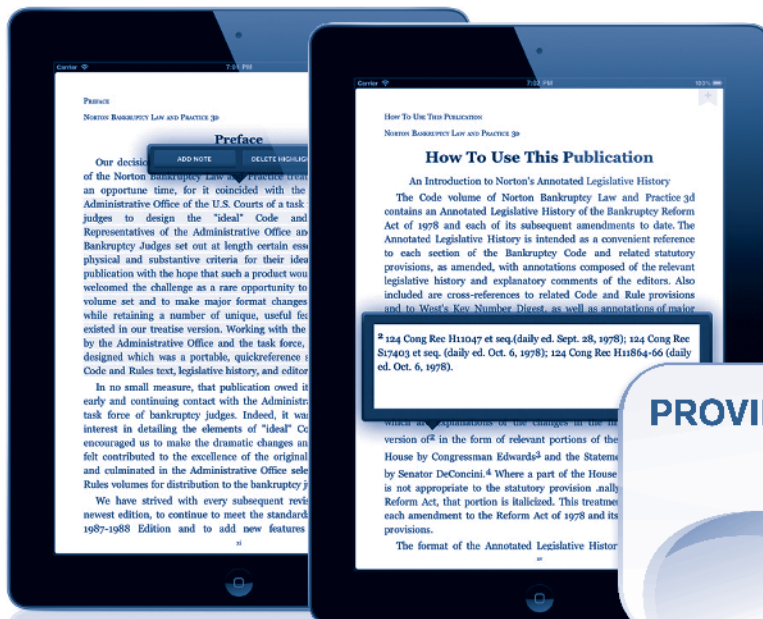

Royal Bank*, (2010) (SCC) - a priority dispute between a credit union's unperfected *PPSA* security interest and a subsequent s. 427 *Bank Act* interest. There is no actual conflict in operation of the statutes in the type of dispute raised in both cases, because the Saskatchewan *PPSA* does not require the bank's compliance and does not restrict the enforceability of the bank's interest.

New Solutions Financial Corp v. Credit Union Central of Ontario (2011) (Ont SCJ) - in Ontario a security interest extends to proceeds generated and received by a third party.

Deering v. Scugog (Township), (2010) (Ont.S.C.J.)

The municipalities failed in their duties to maintain the road in reasonable repair. The municipalities had “rehabilitated” the road and opened it without any markings, signage, or any assessment of the potential hazard.

Hutton v. General Motors of Canada Ltd., (2010) (Alta. Q.B.)

The court dealt with a claim for a defective air bag holding that the company failed in its duty respecting a recall and the description of the risk.

- Introduction of Bill 55, *Education Amendment Act (Organ Donation Education) 2010*, to promote organ donation education by requiring that every school board establish in the senior secondary school division a curriculum which stresses the importance of organ donation.
- Amendments to the *Education Act* by the *Good Government Act, 2011, S.O. 2011, c. 1, Sch. 3*, regarding French-language programs for English pupils.
- Amendments to the *Education Act* by the *Better Tomorrow for Ontario Act (Budget Measures) 2011, S.O. 2011, c. 9, Sch. 10*, regarding the delivery of extended day or third party programs.

NEW CASE LAW DEVELOPMENTS COVERED IN THIS EDITION INCLUDE:

- *British Columbia (Ministry of Education) v. Moore (2010)* - a human rights case alleging that a student with dyslexia had been discriminated against when the specialized facility for intensive remediation was closed for financial reasons prior to his attendance. The British Columbia Court of Appeal held that the student was not entitled to a perfect result, only a reasonable attempt to identify his condition and address his needs. A strong dissent by Rowles, J.A., who opined the majority artificially narrowed the analysis and diverted attention from the real issue of whether disabled students were given the means to equally access the benefit of general education services, coupled with the Supreme Court of Canada's recently granting leave to appeal, ensures that the debate continues.
- Case concerning admission of student diagnosed with hearing loss (but still within normal limits) into a school for the deaf, wherein Court affirmed that it was insufficient for the Provincial Schools Admission Committee to solely consider audiological testing on hearing loss in determining existence of "auditory handicap". Speech pathologist's attendance at committee to give oral report, without informing parents and allowing their attendance, created appearance of unfairness, and parents were entitled to more detailed explanation as to why and in what respect their child was denied placement.
- Case concerning identification and placement of exceptional pupils under s. 17(1) of the *Education Act*. In dismissing an application for judicial review of a Special Education Appeal Board's decision denying a student a regular class placement, the court affirmed that while integration should be recognized as the norm of general application, there is no legal presumption in favour of regular class placement.

- An expulsion case where the Divisional Court exercised its discretion to hear a matter that had become moot because the student had graduated. Application for judicial review of the Child and Family Services Review Board's decision to quash an expulsion committee's decision to expel a student for off-school property drug use was dismissed.
- A Supreme Court of Canada case affirming that teaching is a public profession and teachers are expected to maintain professionalism in their personal and professional lives. Relevant to their suitability to teach is their off duty conduct, even when not directly related to students.
- Case strengthening the electronic privacy rights of employees where the Ontario Court of Appeal held that a teacher had a reasonable expectation of privacy to personal material stored on a lap top computer supplied by the school.

A successful charter case where a university's review committee's decision to discipline students for posting negative professor comments on a social networking website was quashed on appeal.

Reg. 224/10 - "Full Day Junior Kindergarten and Kindergarten" - This regulation provides details regarding the implementation of the full-day early learning programs for four and five-year olds that commenced in 2010, including a table identifying each school and the year in which it will begin offering the full day program.
- O. Reg. 234/10 - "*Principal and Vice-Principal Performance Appraisal*" - This regulation applies to performance appraisals of principals and vice-principals conducted under Part XI.1 of the Act, and includes details regarding the five year evaluation cycle, the review and rating process and the duties and powers of the positions.
- O. Reg. 361/10 - "*Audit Committees*" - This regulation specifies details regarding the mandate of audit committees, including procedures for their establishment and composition, their duties and powers, and remuneration and compensation.
